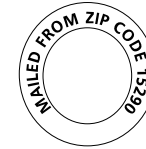
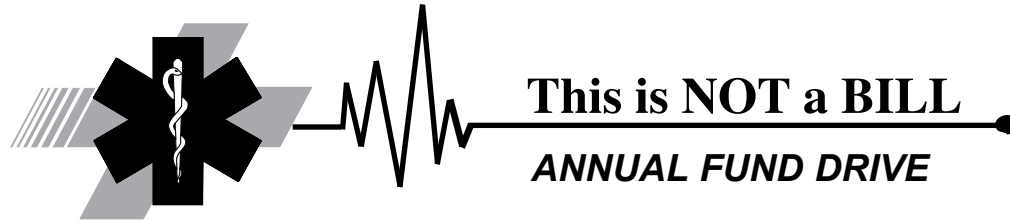

Dear Neighbor,

We DO NOT BILL for OUR services and none of our members are PAID.

However, you may have seen a bill from Township of PARSIPPANY-TROY HILLS, SAINT CLARE's HEALTH SYSTEM or ATLANTIC HEALTH SYSTEM for ambulance service. This has nothing to do with us, the hospital may bill for the Paramedics using the term ambulance service. If you happen to call 9-1-1 during the day time hours Monday-Saturday there is a good chance you might get PAR-TROY EMS, this Emergency Medical Service (EMS) is provided to supplement the Volunteer Services during the week day. PAR-TROY EMS is a municipal paid service that BILLS for their services, however, as a resident if you do not have insurance or your insurance will not cover some or all of the cost, call them to get that portion of the bill waived. This fund drive, which is mailed in the month of April with a reminder in October for people who may have forgotten, and a quarterly stipend from the Township is our primarily source of income.

We maintain our own vehicles, equipment, insurance and the supplies that we use. In addition, we have to pay for educational training including the initial EMT course and all of the necessary recertification classes for all our members. We have a very active Junior Squad, who are between the ages of 16 and 17 and they work with the members over age 18 to gain valuable experience in the field of EMS.
